John of the Cross

In the 1560's his name was John of St. Matthias. In 1568 he took the name of **John of the Cross**, He and four others opened the first men's house of Discalced (barefooted) Carmelites at Duruelo in Spain. In 1570, **St John of the Cross** became rector of the Carmelite house of studies at Alcal'a. That year he was subjected to a grave spiritual trial. Dryness, scruples, temptations, and desolation made him feel that God had abandoned him.
