To keep you all informed of where we stand club wise, we said we would do updates more frequently. Your House Finance committee meets formally once a month and informally as we have something to discuss. The club has been doing better for the last two years. We last reported to you two months ago. We continue to pay extra on the loan and we have made some extra payments only on the Principle. We have seen the loan balance come down from \$303,069.62 on Dec 1st, 2015 to \$285,227.05 on July 15th, 2016. We are current on ALL bills, we pay the bills ahead of their due dates. We have replaced the Bar Stools, paying cash, and we have replaced the Deep Fryers, again paying cash. The party room has been Cleaned up and repainted. We have begun work on refinishing the wood surfaces of the bar. We have to do that work when we have a several day party gap to allow work to be done, as well as the worker having time in his schedule that coordinates with No Party Rentals. So, please continue to support us, and if you have not been down to visit your club facility in a while then maybe it is time that you come in and provide some support.
