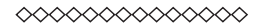
MEMBERSHIP

At this time Tinker Meals will be on hold.

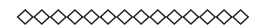

Cooking Crew leader please advise Dennis by the 15th of the month with what you will cook on your Wednesday next month. Thanks.

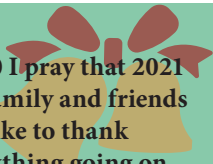
