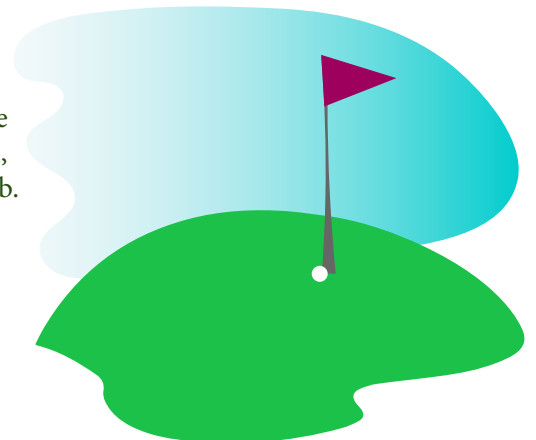

A NEW CHALLENGE

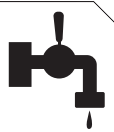
