going to have a meeting the 1st Thursday of the month immediately following our Fraternal meeting. This change was brought about to bring more transparency to Columbian Homes.

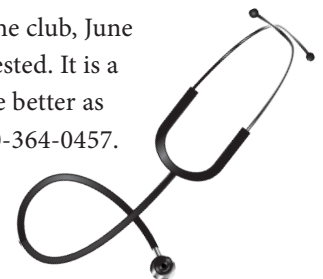
