Happy Halloween to everyone.

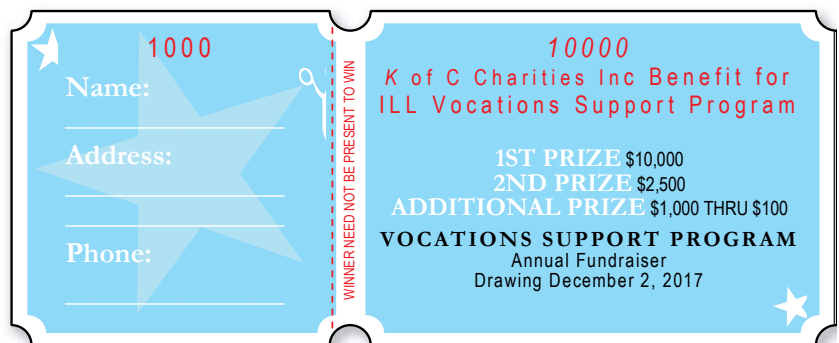
Remember Thanksgiving is just around the corner, and we as Americans have a lot to be Thankful for.

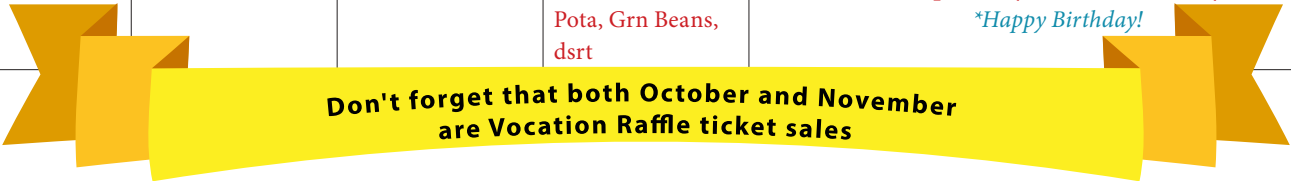
